6. Health Hazard Data

Signs and Symptoms of Exposure

1. Acute Overexposure

7. Spill or Leak Procedures

Steps to be taken in case material is released or spilled: Ventilate area and eliminate all sources of ignition. Do not allow material to contaminate ground and surface waters. Use an absorbent specifically used for chemical spills to recover material. Discard use absorbent in conformance with local, state and federal regulations.

Storage and Handling: Store in a cool, dry area. Aerosol cans must be stored below 120 F to prevent rupturing.

Waste Disposal: All used and unused product should be disposed of in conformance with local, state and federal regulations.

Vapors will collect in low areas; be sure to use with adequate ventilation. Do not use near potential sources of ignition. Avoid inhaling vapor and contact with eyes and skin.
