Dear Mr. Katz:

This is in reply to your request for compound authorization received on April 19, 1991 for your product CRC Industrial Gasket Remover.

This product is acceptable as a paint remover for use in nonprocessing areas of official establishments operating under the Federal meat and poultry products inspection program. Equipment and utensils which directly contact edible products must be thoroughly cleaned and rinsed with potable water after treatment with such products before being returned to a processing area.

The final granting of authorization to use such products which do not come in direct or indirect contact with edible products or packaging materials is the responsibility of the inspector in charge of the official plant. Technical assistance will be provided by the Product Safety Branch upon request.

Acceptance of compounds by this Department is in no way to be construed as an endorsement of the compounds or of any claims made for them.

If any change is made in the labeling information or formulation, the authorization for use in official plants becomes void immediately.
