Dear Mr. Katz:

This is in reply to your request for compound authorization received on June 15, 1993 for your product CRC Industrial Belt Dressing No. 03065 (REVISED).

This product is chemically acceptable as a belt dressing in official establishments operating under the Federal meat and poultry products inspection program. The compound must be used in a manner which prevents direct or indirect contamination of edible products.

The final granting of authorization for the proposed use of such compounds is the responsibility of the inspector in charge of the official plant. Technical assistance will be provided by the Compounds and Packaging Branch upon request.

Acceptance of this compound will be indicated in the "List of Proprietary Substances and Nonfood Compounds." However, the acceptable use(s) stated above will not be indicated. Copies of this letter must be supplied to Federal inspectors as proof of the acceptable use(s) of the compound.

Acceptance of compounds by this Department is in no way to be construed as an endorsement of the compounds or of any claims made for them.

If any change is made in the labeling information or formulation, the authorization for use in official plants becomes void immediately.
