Dear Mr. Reed:

This is in reply to your request for compound authorization received on June 18, 1979

Your product Zinc Re-Nu No. 03087 & No. 03075 is chemically acceptable as a coating for application to structural surfaces or surfaces where there is a possibility of incidental food contact in official establishments operating under the Federal meat and poultry products inspection program. This letter does not authorize use of the coating on any surface where there is direct or prolonged contact with food.

The final granting of authorization to use such coatings on structural surfaces such as walls or ceilings, or on equipment surfaces below the product zone, is the responsibility of the inspector in charge of the official plant. Before applying the coating to an equipment surface in or above the product zone, you must obtain clearance from the Equipment Group, Technical Services Staff of the Meat and Poultry Inspection Program in Washington, DC 20250. Technical advice will be provided by the Chemistry Staff upon request.

Acceptance of compounds by this Department is in no way to be construed as an endorsement of the compounds or of any claims made for them.

If any change is made in the labeling information or formulation, the authorization for use in official plants becomes void immediately.

The above acceptance of this compound will not be indicated in the publication, "List of Chemical Compounds." This letter acts as continuing authorization for its use under the conditions stated above.
