DIRECTIONS: Read entire label before using this product.

For filling alcohol evaporators – fill jar about two thirds full of AVIEX® Premium Air Brake Anti-Freeze. When compressor is compressing air, bubbles should be passing through the Air Brake Anti-Freeze. Check to insure all connections are tight and that filter cap and cover are in good condition.

DANGER ☠ **POISON.** Contains Methanol 67-56-1. Cannot be made non-poisonous. Avoid contact with eyes. Use only in a well ventilated area. Product is extremely flammable and should be kept away from all heat, flames and other ignition sources.

FIRST AID: In case of eye contact, flush immediately with water for 15 minutes. If swallowed, induce vomiting, then give two teaspoons of baking soda in a glass of water. Get medical attention immediately. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water immediately.

For small spills, use absorbent and sweep into closed containers for disposal. For large spills evacuate the area, dike and transfer into containers for disposal.
