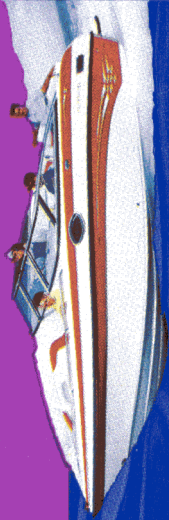

DIRECTIONS: Read entire label before using this product. Brush a thick coat of Rust Stain Remover on area to be treated. For best results, allow product to sit for at least 60 seconds. Rinse off. For tough stains, repeat application.

FIRST AID: INTERNAL – If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. Immediately give large quantities of water or milk. If vomiting does occur, give fluids again. Call a physician immediately.
EYE CONTACT – Immediately flush the eyes with large quantities of running water for a minimum of 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention as soon as possible. Continue the flushing for an additional 15 minutes if the physician is not immediately available.
SKIN CONTACT – Immediately remove contaminated clothing. Flush all affected areas with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention immediately.
INHALATION – If too much is breathed, remove to fresh air. For severe overexposure, call a physician immediately. Vapors are heavier than air and can collect in low areas. If ventilation is not adequate, respiratory protection should be used.

HANDLING AND SPILL PRECAUTIONS: Keep container closed. Wash thoroughly after handling.
FOR SPILLS, use proper protective equipment. Take precautions as necessary to prevent contamination of ground or surface water. For small spills, use absorbent and sweep into closed containers for disposal.

DISPOSAL: Unused contents, and containers must be disposed of in accordance with all federal, state and local regulations. Do not dump in sewers, on the ground or into any body of water. For additional information, consult the Material Safety Data Sheet for this product.
